

Our members can submit up to three articles, research papers, posters, art, interview transcripts, photography every month and in return will receive community service hours.

Articles: Brief summary on a specific topic you choose. (3 community service hours)

- Includes facts and basic general information (100-300 words)

Research Papers: A more in detail article where you provide evidence, sources, and possible solutions/action being taken or that could be taken in correlation to your paper. (5 community service hours)

- Do your own research
- Provide evidence and support your claim
- (100-500 words)

Posters: A one pager bringing awareness to a specific cause. (2 community service hours)

- If you do something digital you can submit it in the google form
- If you do something tangible then hang it up in a public space and take a picture of it being hung and where.

Art: You can choose to make art to express yourself and the issue

- It can be digital art or physical, but if physical you will need to do something with it. For example, donate it to a hospital or hang it at your school to help spread awareness. (This one can range from 2 - 5 community service hours)

Interview transcripts: Find someone to interview about a specific cause and copy down the transcript and a brief introduction and conclusion. (3 community service hours)

- The person you are interviewing must be directly related to what you are writing about
- Be respectful and understanding of others boundaries

Photography: You can take pictures that capture a certain issue. (3 community service hours)

- Be creative and use this to spread awareness
- It can be anything from pictures of a neighborhood after a natural disaster or it can be pictures of a fundraiser for a certain cause
